Including data from PM Training Survey and the Registry




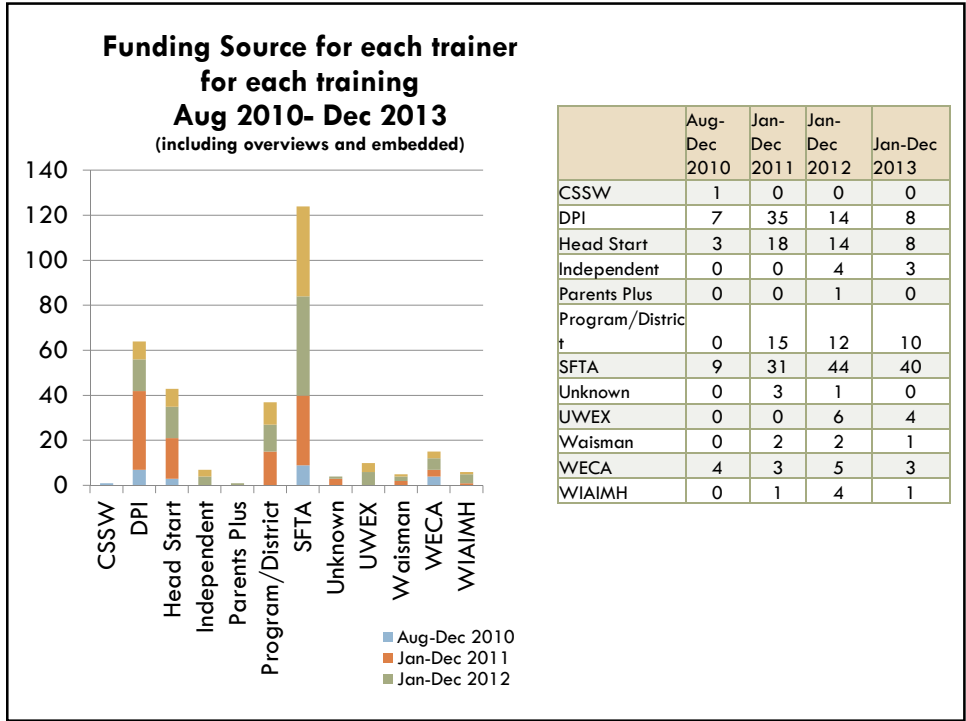




With data from Registry and PM Training Report in Survey Monkey

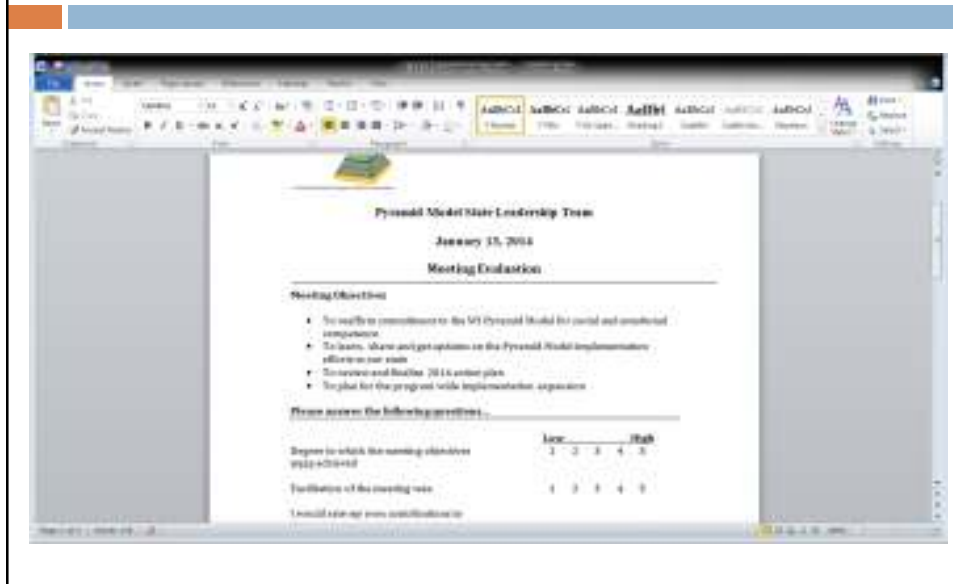
