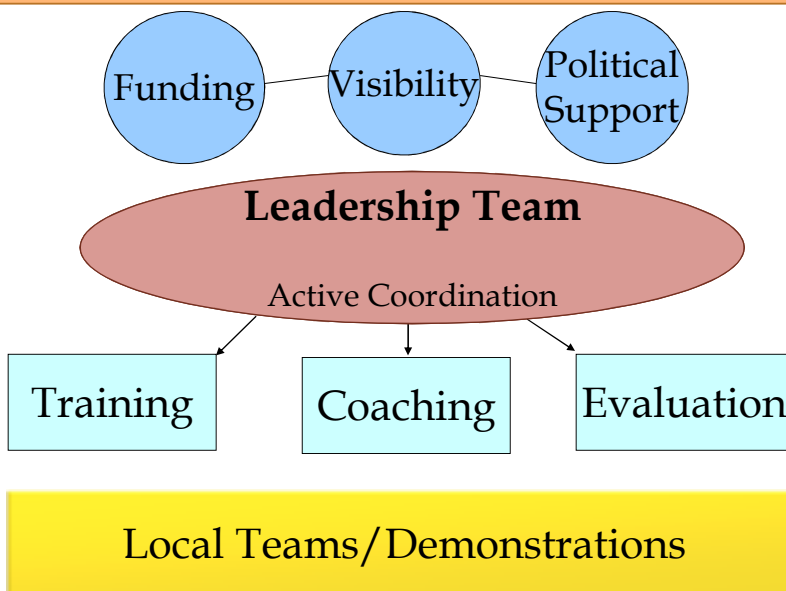

Safe Schools Healthy Students EC workgroup



- ❧ Increase the number of 4K and 5K programs as well as public school head starts using the Pyramid Model
- ❧ Prepare these programs through infrastructure development to increase implementation success.
- ❧ Social emotional screening guidance
 1. Support to offset costs of internal coaching
 2. Increase awareness Pyramid Model with public school administrators
 3. Pyramid Model “presence” on DPI website
 4. Incentive/ acknowledgement of Pyramid Model program wide implementation in public schools
 5. Guidance to bridge Pyramid Model with PBIS- especially in K.

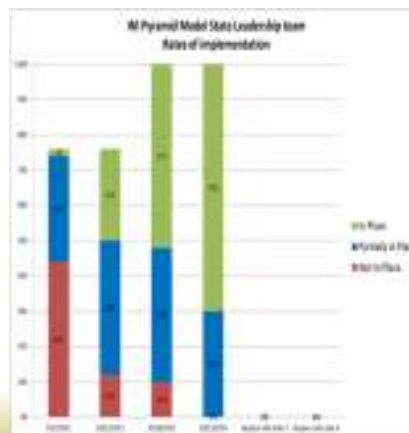
