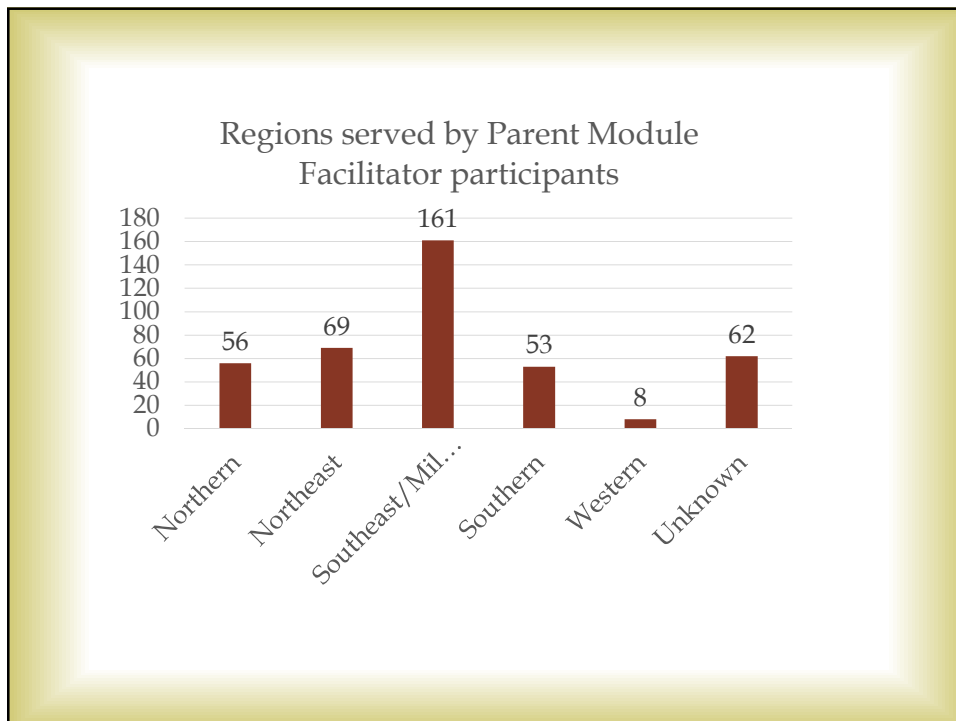
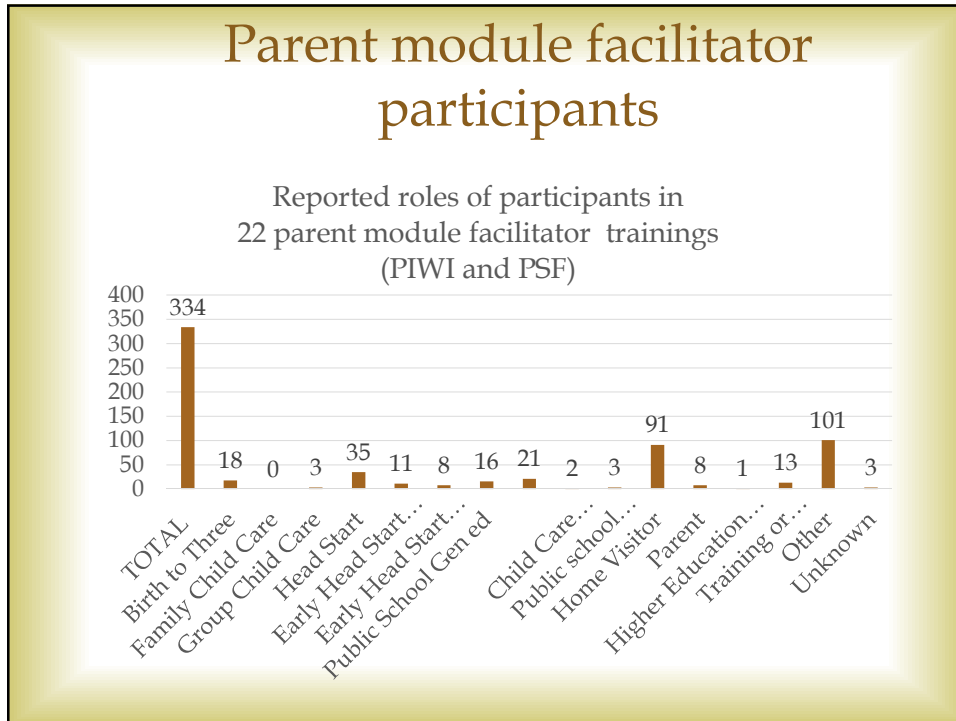
 N = Novice: Has participated in training preparation, but not yet completed training

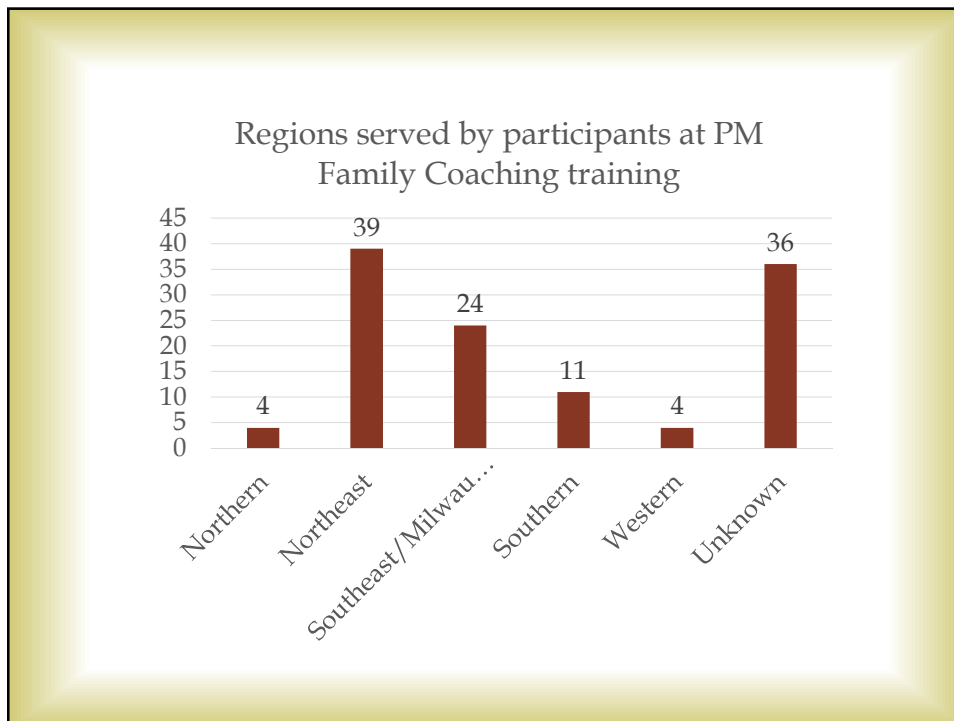
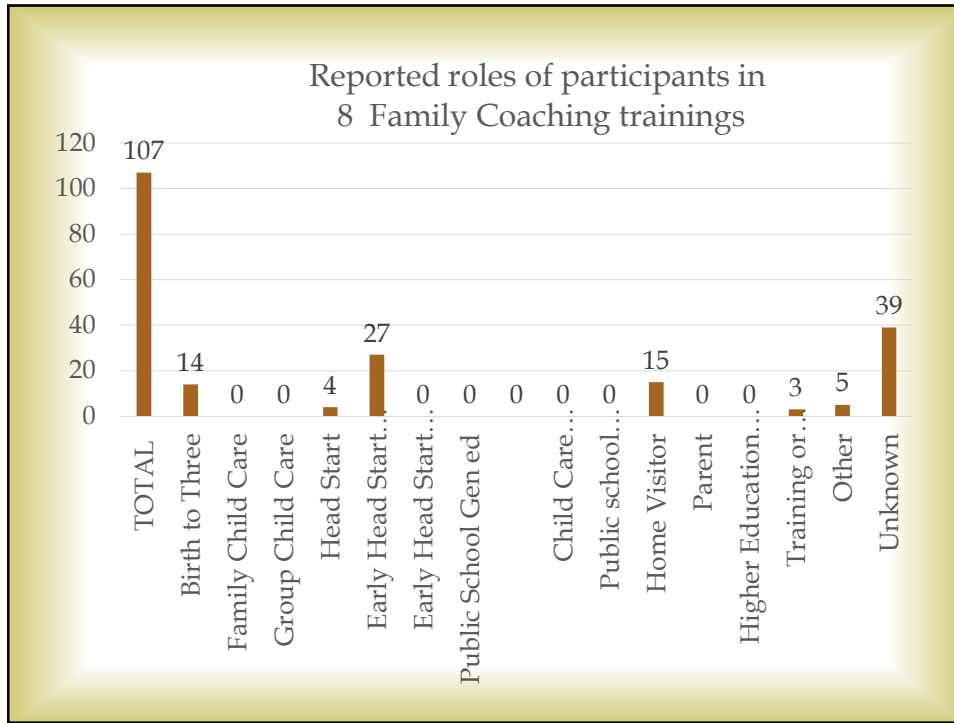
 EM = Emergent: Has completed 1-3 trainings

 EX = Experienced: Has completed 4-6 trainings

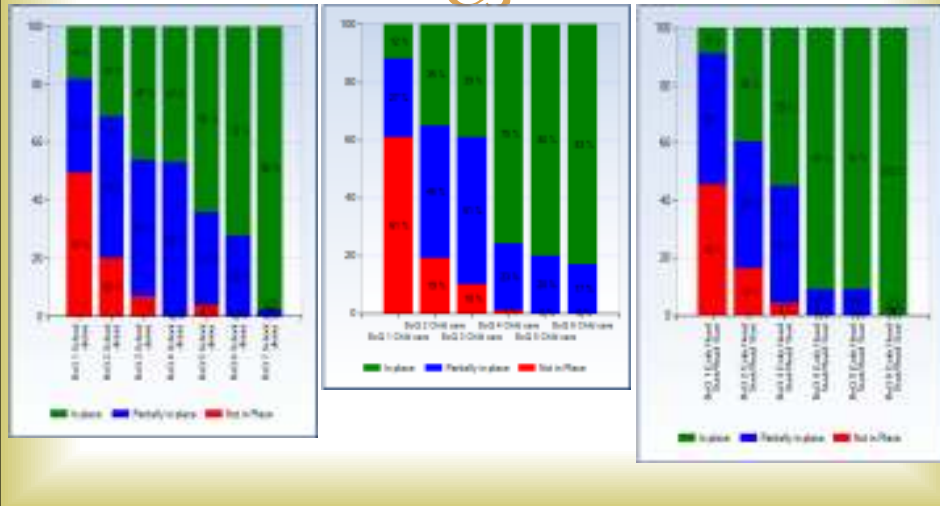
 M = Mentor: Has completed 7 or more trainings
